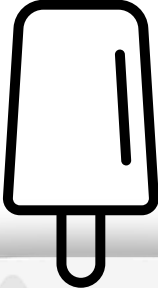
- Read at least 5 times during the week

Yeti wants to share some ice pops with his friends. Help him collect them by coloring in an ice pop for every day you read.

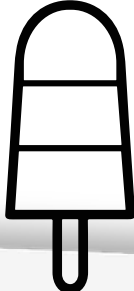
