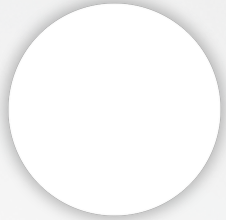
Turn in anytime between July 13–August 1

- Bring your completed log to the Youth Services Desk to get a prize and receive a new log

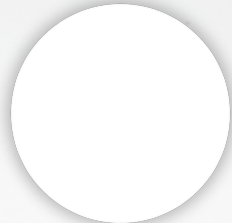
Our Mermaid friend is looking for some beautiful pearls. Help her collect them by coloring in a pearl for every day you read.
